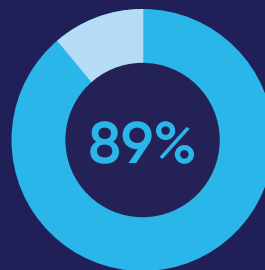

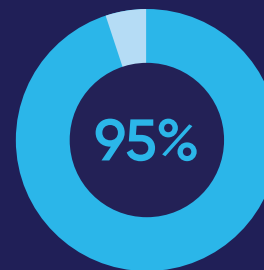

of delegates rated the overall quality of the Visual Presentations as 'Good' or 'Excellent'*

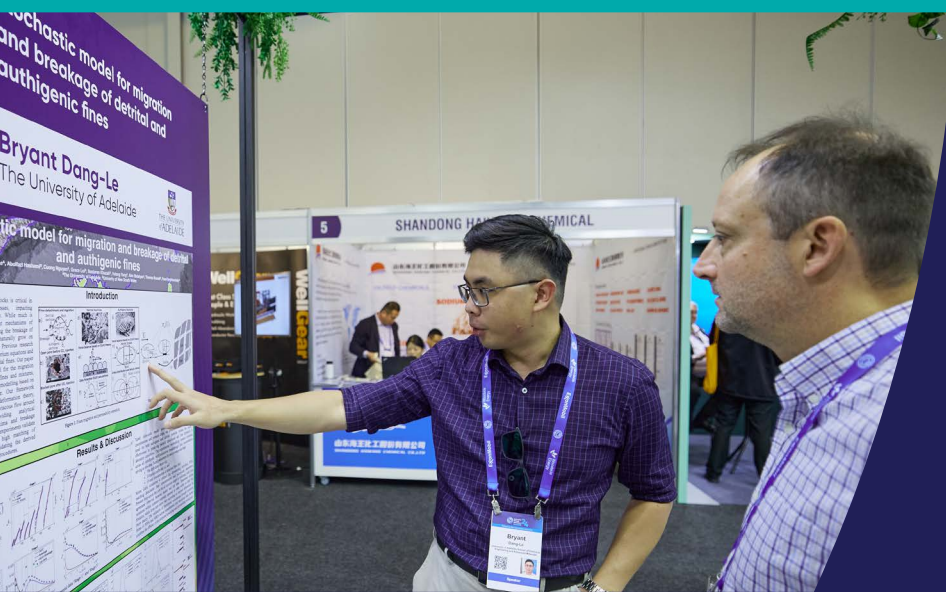
